

Paris 2024 Olympic Games: what impact for Bateaux-Mouches®?

As you know, Paris will be hosting the Olympic Games **from 26 July to 11 August**, a global event that will be a source of pride and sharing for Parisians. An event for all visitors to the capital, a great celebration in the most beautiful city in the world!

But a party on this scale has to be prepared well in advance... and that inevitably means certain constraints. The Compagnie des Bateaux-Mouches® site is located in the heart of an area that will be subject to major traffic and access restrictions.

Operational timetable for the Paris 2024 Olympic Games at Bateaux-Mouches®.

Site access

Access to the Port de la Conférence will be modified for a few weeks:

From 1 to 18 July and from 28 July to 4 August, parking will not be possible on the quay of the Port de la Conférence, neither for cars nor for buses. Access to the boarding pontoon will be pedestrian only and will be via the central staircase. (Access for stroller and PRMs will still be possible via the ramp on the Pont de l'Alma side).

Temporary closure of the site :

Preparations for the 2024 Olympic Games will have an impact on cruises. Sailing will therefore have to be stopped. Our site will even be completely closed to the public **from 18 July to 26 July inclusive**.

Dates and periods of closure :


- MONDAY 17 JUNE FROM 5AM TO 12PM : FIRST DEPARTURE 12.30 PM
- MONDAY 24 JUNE FROM 5AM TO 12PM : FIRST DEPARTURE 2 PM
- FROM SATURDAY 18 TO FRIDAY 26 JULY (CEREMONY) : TOTAL CLOSURE OF OPERATIONS
- SATURDAY 27 JULY : FIRST DEPARTURE 2 PM
- SUNDAY 28 TO 31 JULY FROM 2AM TO 11AM (EVENT) : FIRST DEPARTURE 11.30 AM
- FRIDAY 2 TO 8 AUGUST FROM 2AM TO 11AM (EVENT) : FIRST DEPARTURE 11.30 AM
- SATURDAY 9 AUGUST FROM 2AM TO 11AM (EVENT) : FIRST DEPARTURE 11.30 AM
- SUNDAY 10 AUGUST FROM 2AM TO 11AM (EVENT) : FIRST DEPARTURE 11.30 AM
- THURSDAY 29 TO SATURDAY 31 AUGUST FROM 2AM TO 11AM (EVENT): FIRST DEPARTURE 11.30 AM
- SUNDAY 1 AND MONDAY 2 SEPTEMBER FROM 2AM TO 12PM (EVENT) : FIRST DEPARTURE 12.30 PM
- TUESDAY 3 SEPTEMBER FROM 2AM TO 12PM (EVENT) : FIRST DEPARTURE 12.30 PM

How do I get to the Bateaux-Mouches® during the Olympic Games?

Traffic will be severely restricted during the Olympic Games, and we strongly advise you to walk or use public transport to get to the Port de la Conférence, where the Compagnie des Bateaux-Mouches[®] embarks.

On foot

Our site is freely accessible on foot throughout the period of the Olympic Games. Access to the platform is via the central staircase on the Cours La Reine.

Metro

Pont de l'Alma station will be closed **from 18 to 27 July. Reopening scheduled for 28 July.** Champs-Élysées - Clemenceau station will be closed **from 1 July to 21 September**.



RER STATION

Pont de l'Alma station (RER C) will be closed **from 18 to 26 July**. However, it will be open throughout the Olympic Games.



Bus

All services on lines 72 and 42 will be suspended between **18 July and 21 September**.





Taxis and VTCs will be able to access the restricted traffic zones. Customers will be dropped off on the Cours La Reine **from 27 July to 4 August**, then directly on the quay **from 5 August**.

Coaches



ccess modified **from 27 July to 4 August**: Coaches will have to drop off and pick up their passengers on the Cours la Reine.

Free access to the platform from 5 August.
